

## Winter Moisture and Your Retractable Screens

When there is any moisture outside, even morning dew, this can "freeze" your screens. If they are in the down position, the pile can freeze on the ground and if you raise them, it can damage the pile, or worse, damage the screen itself. Just wait until it warms up and continue to enjoy your screens.

The moisture may affect the fabric itself. When the temperatures are freezing or below, the fabric may be "frozen" due to the moisture. Wait until it warms up before you move the screens.

Your screens can be run in cold weather but just be mindful of any freezing rain, moisture, or snow that could have gathered on your screens.
